Oikos Evangelism

- Luke 10:1-9
- This is the heart of all Christian mission
- The Person of Peace
- Wendy's Legacy

Oikos Evangelism

- Organized outreach and evangelism is a response to the endemic dysfunction in the Western Church
- Organized efforts are acceptable for harnessing resources for societal transformation

Life-Pattern Teaching

- Jesus lived in community (a shared life together) with His disciples.
- Life was the curriculum
- Jesus taught the multitudes about the Kingdom, but He explained the Kingdom to His disciples.

Follower types and time investment

- Crowd
- Casual
- Core

Moving from committed to devoted

- Committed are *agenda* driven - motivated by personal desires/needs
- Devoted are *Kingdom* driven - motivated by loving obedience

Circles of relationships: 3, 12, 72, multitudes

- The Multitudes: the crowd / congregation
- The 72: “Lay” leaders / leaders in training
- The 12: Strategic Transformers
- The 3: The Catalytic Leaders

Key Point

- Jesus had to show them the Father — all ministry is incarnational.

His teaching revolved around three things - all were “I/Thou”:

- Who God was (God-awareness)
- Who they were in relation to God (Self-awareness)
- Who they were in relation to others (Other-awareness)

He used both words and works to instruct about the Kingdom:

- John 14:12
- Matthew 11:1-5

We remember:

- 10% of what we read
- 20% percent of what we hear
- 30% of what we see
- 50 % of what hear and see
- 70% of what we say ourselves
- 90% of what do ourselves

Cycle of Learning

- Disciple learns by hearing
- Disciple learns by seeing how it is done
- Disciple learns by doing it
- Disciple learns by teaching it to others

Relational Learning Model

- I do, you watch
- I do, you help
- You do, I'll help
- You do, I watch
- You do - someone else watches
